Job Title Café Barista Assistant

The Café Barista Assistants will provide an excellent level of service for the sports café services, following the food service and food quality guidelines set up by the Director of Catering at Folio Education Trust. The focus is for efficient food preparation and delivery for students, staff and external customers. This role is part of our cafe team, which comprises seven friendly, ambitious and hard-working assistants, to offer 7-day shift-based rolling service.

This job description is a newly devolved post and is subject to review and amendment through annual negotiation as the role develops in scope.

#### **Key Duties**

- Preparing and serving food, hot and cold drinks such as coffee, tea, and speciality beverages.
- > Cleaning and sanitising work areas, utensils and equipment.
- Cleaning of the service and seating area.
- Describing menu items and suggesting products to customers.

- Servicing customers and taking orders.
- Ordering, receiving and replenishing stock.
- Receiving and processing customer payments.
